Direct Debit Guarantee

This is a guarantee provided by your own Bank as a member of the Direct Debit Scheme, in which all Banks and Originators of Direct Debits participate.

If you authorise payment by Direct Debit, then:

- Your Direct Debit Originator will notify you in advance of the amounts to be debited to your account.
- Your Bank will accept and pay such debits, provided that your account has sufficient available funds.

If it is established that an unauthorised Direct Debit was charged to your account, you are guaranteed a prompt refund by your Bank of the amount so charged. You can cancel the Direct Debit in good time by writing to your Bank.

Tax Relief Scheme

Did you know that JA can claim back thousands of euro from the Revenue Commissioners each year?

As a supporter of JA a donation of €250 or more over one year could be worth up to 72% more to our work with children in Ireland. The good news is there is no extra cost to you.

By simply filling in the Revenue form enclosed and ticking the appropriate tax bracket, dating and signing and finally returning the form to us we can make our claim. It is really that simple.

What donations qualify for tax relief?

If you are a PAYE taxpayer donations over €250 per annum are eligible. So a direct debit of €21 per month will bring you over the threshold.
